1. CRRA Liaisons Meeting - Mark the Date!

2. CRRA receives award from Catholic Communication Campaign of the USCC (Jennifer A. Younger, Ph.D. CRRA Executive Director)

CRRA received a second award from the Catholic Communication Campaign of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. The \$120,000 will support digitization of the remaining years of the *Catholic News Service* historical newsfeeds (1920-1986) and enable digitization of the *Catholic World in Pictures*, which accompanied the *Catholic News Service* from 1922 – 1961. In addition, some funds will be available to digitize a modest amount of diocesan newspaper content. We will reach out to our current participating diocesan partners as well as to other diocesan papers in the near future.

I thank Pat Lawton, CRRA Digital Initiatives Director, for writing and coordinating all aspects of our grant proposal. Similarly, Todd Jensen, Project Manager, Catholic News Archive and Katherine Nuss, Archivist, USCCB/CNS, who provided invaluable assistance in developing the proposal and compiling the specific information for the budget.

It's a pleasure to highlight too, the successful fundraising being done by our partners. Karen Lesiak, Director, Archbishop O'Brien Library, Archdiocesan Center at Saint Thomas Seminary, secured grant funding to purchase the master negative microfilms of the *Catholic Transcript*, Hartford, CT, from ProQuest, which in turn, dramatically reduces the cost of scanning the paper for conversion. Second, Sarah Patterson, Archdiocesan Archivist, Archdiocese of Cincinnati,

received LSTA funds to digitize some years of the Cincinnati *Telegraph*. We welcome the opportunity to assist all of our partners in raising funds for digitizing their paper.
