



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Microfilm Considerations

• Quality of microfilming

- Consistent? Under/over exposed; in focus
- Complete?
- Condition
 - $\diamond\,$ Negative film, generally a second generation, printing negative (not the master) should be used
 - Send least fragile copy available such as institutional master copy (not archival master).
 - Negative, silver halide film digitizes the best. Positive acceptable if in good condition but will result in lower quality images.
 - Significant wear impacts OCR quality, artifacts and scratches produce poor images and false OCR.
