5. Fundraising activities to grow the membership Outcome: Review of opportunities

- The Membership Committee discussed (February 19, 2014) the pros and cons of raising dues. There is some agreement that dues need to be raised incrementally on a regular basis to avoid periodic larger increases. Larger increases to support strategic initiatives may also be acceptable to the membership. Membership dues will always be an important component of CRRA revenue but are unlikely to yield sufficient funds to do what CRRA wants to do. The Committee highlighted the need to diversify and grow revenue through grants and gifts.
- The Board is working with the Newspapers Task Force on obtaining grant funds for digitizing Catholic newspapers. One value of CRRA membership is to support creation of new resources, such as digital newspapers content. This is a "higher" goal, a responsibility to support global scholarship.

- Seek grants to support participation of content partners. A deliverable to members to provide access to resources not in WorldCat.
- Assist members in obtaining start-up grants for dues, finding aids and digitizing on demand. CRRA can assist in searching *The Catholic Funding Guide*, advise on grant preparation and help members make connections with others for collaboration.
